As you already know from your previous teams, parent involvement plays a big part in the future and success of your team. The Columbia County Quarterback Club is the booster organization that supports the Tigers Football team. We also are an important source for info, your kids will no longer be handed paper with their weekly schedules. They are expected to listen and retain information given to them by the coaching staff in team meetings daily. Did you know that we have 2 football games scheduled in the month of May? The Purple and Gold and the Spring game. Were you aware that we have several fundraising events upcoming? Did you know that we will have conditioning all summer, but there will be weeks scheduled off each month so that you can plan vacations? You may have also asked, since we are in High School now, does the school pay for everything, the answer is NO. So, what does the Quarterback Club spend money on?

- Pre and post-game meals for all the players and staff. (Cost \$7,000. This keeps you from having to send money with your kids to eat dinner or for some kids not eating at all.)
- Training equipment, we are assisting with weight room equipment upgrades, summer camps for players and clinics for our coaches to learn new techniques.
- Transportation costs
- We support the upkeep of the stadium with paint and labor, upgrade of the players locker room, assist in the purchase of new uniforms (players will be provided pants, jerseys, helmets, socks, girdles, mouth pieces, belts, shoulder pads, those who attend the entire summer conditioning will earn a pair of cleats.) Cost to outfit a player- \$1,000 so for 120 players that's an investment of \$120,000.
